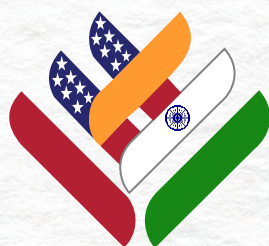

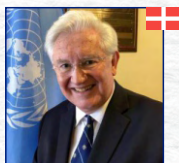

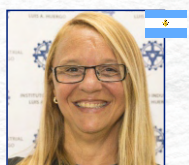

GREEN SCHOOL

Green Schools prepare students to become citizens and leaders who understand how the natural world works, see the patterns that connect human activities with Mother Nature, and have the knowledge, values, and skills to act effectively.

GREEN UNIVERSITY

A **Green University** is an educational institution that meets its need for natural resources without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs.

GREEN ENTERPRISE

The term "**Green Enterprise**" refers to services, products, and jobs from a number of sectors that focus on sustainability, fewer emissions of greenhouse gases, and slowing climate change.

GREEN GOVERNANCE

The concept of responsible **Governance** usually bears strong reference to public governance and questions of responsibility in implementing public policies having minimum impact on the local environment.

GREEN DIPLOMACY

Green Diplomacy is preventive diplomacy that seeks to build resilience and harmonies the interests of the state with the interests of every human being on the planet, concerning the conservation and development of natural conditions of life.

GREEN JUDICIARY

The judicial system guarantee legal certainty determines disputes and protects the rights and the liberties of all with minimizing the impact on the local environment. It also protects individuals and vulnerable groups that cannot protect themselves, along with the rights of animals nature, and natural resources.

GREEN TECHNOLOGY

Green-tech—or **Green Technology**—is an umbrella term that describes the use of technology and science to reduce human impacts on the natural environment. Green technology encompasses a wide area of scientific research, including energy, atmospheric science, agriculture, material science, and hydrology.
