Greening Education Partnership - Getting every learner climate-ready

UNESCO and its partners launched Greening Education Partnership to get every learner climate-ready in September 2022 during the Transforming Education Summit at the United Nations headquarters in New York.

The Greening Education Partnership calls on all countries to commit to four priority areas of action, i.e., Greening schools, Greening learning, Greening capacity, and readiness Greening communities by 2030.

Greening schools

Vision

From early childhood through adult education, work to ensure that all schools achieve green school accreditation, including teacher training and higher education institutions.

Goal

All countries will have adopted a green school accreditation scheme with atleast 50% of schools, colleges, and universities with green accreditation and are operating sustainably.

Greening learning

Vision

Embrace a life-long learning approach that integrates climate education into school curricula, technical and vocational education and training, workplace skills development, teaching materials, pedagogy, and assessment.

Goal

The number of countries which include climate education in school curricula at the pre-primary, primary, and secondary levels will have at least doubled from the current 45%.

Greening capacity and readiness

Vision

Support teachers and policymakers through the integration of climate education in pre-service and in-service teacher training, building the capacity of school leaders and key education stakeholders.

Goal

All school leaders and at least one teacher per school will have been trained on how to integrate climate education into teaching and learning throughout the school.

Greening communities

Vision

Engage the entire community by integrating climate education in life-long learning, in particular, through community learning centers and learning cities.

Goal

All countries will be able to report at least three different ways learning opportunities are made available for adults outside the formal education system to develop the skills, attitudes, and actions that will foster community resilience to tackle climate change.






Special Consultative Status with the Economic and Social Council of United Nations from 2021

Each Green University Auditing & certification indicator is in turn measured against a set of global standards for the Green Learning Spaces Auditing and accreditation Process.

Every responsible academic Institution has the potential to become a full-fledged Green University- by meeting the global standard and quality and responsible education. Green University accepts accountability to the students and responsibility to the planet.

Green Mentors encourages every University or College to achieve Green Accreditation as its responsibility to honor the Call of the United Nations towards Greening Education Partnership-Getting every learner Climate-ready.

Green Univerity Accreditation is recommended for all National and Internationa Accreditation, including NAAC, NIRF & ARIIA.
