GREENING Education Partnership Getting every learner Climate-ready



UNESCO and its partners launched Greening Education Partnership to get every learner climate-ready in September 2022 during the Transforming Education Summit at the United Nations headquarters in New York.

The Greening Education Partnership calls on all countries to commit to four priority areas of action, i.e., **Greening schools**, **Greening learning**, **Greening**



75% OF YOUNG PEOPLE SAY THAT THEY ARE FRIGHTENED ABOUT THEIR FUTURE

The earth's average Global Temperature has risen by 1°c with most of the warming occurring in the past 35 years.

Around half of the 100 countries reviewed had no mention of climate change in their national curriculum, UNESCO findings reveal.

While 95% of surveyed primary and secondary teachers felt that teaching climate change is important, less than 30% expressed a readiness to teach it.



CONTEXT

With accelerated climate change, our planet's fragility is becoming more apparent. In addition, persistent inequalities, social fragmentation, and political extremism are bringing many societies to the point of crisis.

VISION

Knowledge and learning are humanity's most significant renewable resources for responding to challenges and inventing alternatives. Yet, education does more than respond to a changing world. Education can only transform the World.

REASON

Knowledge and learning are humanity's most significant renewable resources for responding to challenges and inventing alternatives. Yet, education does more than respond to a changing world. Education can only transform the World.

Pedagogy should enhance the spirit of cooperation, collaboration and solidarity principles. It should foster the students' intellectual, social, and moral capacities to work together and transform the world with empathy and compassion.

Assessment should reflect these pedagogical goals in ways that promote meaningful growth and learning for all students.

The curriculum should emphasize ecological, intercultural and interdisciplinary learning that supports students to access and produce knowledge while developing their capacity to analyze and apply it.

Curriculam must embrace an ecological understanding of humanity that rebalances how we relate to Earth as a living planet and our singular home.

Teachers should be knowledge producers, not only knowledge providers because teachers are critical figures in educational and social transformation. Moreover, more professionalized teaching brings more learning outcomes to the classrooms.

Reflection, Research and the creation of knowledge and new pedagogical practices should become an integral part of responsible teaching. Collaboration and teamwork should characterize the work of teachers.

Learners should enjoy and expand the educational opportunities throughout life and in different cultural and social spaces. At all times of life, people should have meaningful, quality educational opportunities.





EDUCATION

Education is a purposeful activity to achieve specific aims, such as transmitting knowledge or fostering skills and character traits. These aims include the development of understanding, rationality, kindness, and honesty.

The primary purpose of education is to provide the opportunity to acquire knowledge and skills that will enable people to develop their full potential and become successful fellows of the society.

PRESENT EDUCATION

The education system is primarily guided, governed and aided by the State, but hardly any State accepts accountability to the pupils and responsibility to the planet.

Presently States and Philanthropic organizations establish schools and universities, develop curriculam, determine requirements for enrollment and confer graduation certificates with compromised learning outcomes and no responsibilities for livelihood opportunities.



RESPONSIBLE EDUCATION

Responsible education is a blend of the local language, local culture, local value systems, local games, local food habits, local rituals associated with local livelihood, and local environment that brings a sustainable future for every child.

When an education system accepts accountability to the future of its pupils by offering personalized curriculum, teaching pedagogy, and co-curricular activities to achieve the desired learning outcome with physical, social, and emotional well-being along with the responsibility to the planet by minimizing the impact on the local environment is known as Responsible Education.

Responsible education eliminates every social, cultural, and economic barrier that comes in the way of achieving success and accelerates the joy of learning
